

Bearing the mighty red kangaroo, each design captures their distinct bounding movement.



2018 Year of the Dog bullion coins

These magnificent Australian Lunar gold and silver coins celebrate the Year of the Dog, one of 12 animals associated with the ancient Chinese lunar calendar.

The birth years for people ruled by the Chinese Lunar dog include 1922, 1934, 1946, 1958, 1970, 1982, 1994, 2006 and 2018. Those born under the influence of this sign are said to be loyal, amiable, kind and friendly.



2018 Kookaburra & Koala bullion coins

Depicting two of Australia's most beloved fauna, the Australian kookaburra and koala silver coins pay tribute to our rich wildlife.

Updated annually, these designs are part of an ongoing series of stunning originality and craft.





Design

The reverse of each small gold coin portrays two kangaroos bounding across a stylised rural landscape. The reverse of the 1 kilo gold coin depicts the classic artistry of the iconic bounding red kangaroo surrounded by rays of sunlight.

Each coin design also incorporates the inscription Australian Kangaroo, the 2018 year-date, the weight and purity, and The Perth Mint's traditional 'P' mintmark.

The Ian Rank-Broadley effigy of Her Majesty Queen Elizabeth II and the monetary denomination are shown on the obverse of each coin.

The reverse of both coins depict the classic artistry of a bounding red kangaroo surrounded by rays of sunlight.

The inscription Australian Kangaroo, The Perth Mint's traditional 'P' mintmark, the 2018 year-date, and the weight and purity are also included in the design.

The obverse of each coin bears the lan Rank-Broadley effigy of Her Majesty Queen Elizabeth II and the monetary denomination.

Security feature (SILVER ONLY)

The coin's reverse includes a security feature in the form of a micro-laser

engraved letter within the coin's AUSTRALIAN KANGAROO heading.

Presentation (SILVER ONLY)

The silver kangaroo is presented without capsule in protective acrylic tubes of 25 coins. There are 10 tubes to a mini monster box.

The reverse of each coin depicts a German Shepherd dog and pup lying in grass with Chinese peony flowers in the background. The design also incorporates the Chinese character for 'dog', the inscription 'Year of the Dog' and The Perth Mint's traditional 'P' mintmark.

The Ian Rank-Broadley effigy of Her Majesty Queen Elizabeth II, the 2018 year-date, the weight and purity, and the monetary denomination are shown on the obverse of each coin.

The obverse of each coin bears the lan Rank-Broadley effigy of Her Majesty Queen Elizabeth II and the monetary denomination.
